(3) Membership of a multi-county local board shall be no less than fifteen (15) and no more than twenty (30) members.

Important: When reviewing your board membership is cognizant of the 10% rule as written in the legislation: 10 KAR 7:010 Section 3. (7) “Representatives appointed under any paragraph in this section, excluding subsection (5) (a) (Judge/Executive) of this section, shall not comprise more than ten (10) percent of the total board membership.”

Section 3. (8)

“Representation from health departments and community mental health centers shall be equivalent.”

Local Boards with membership rosters that do not adhere to Section 3. (7) and (8) will be deemed out of compliance with state regulations.

An example of a multi-county local board out of compliance would be one that has more than two (3) members representing any one group/agency.
